



HOME FIELD REQUIREMENTS AND RESTRICTIONS

AT THE CLUBHOUSE

- Spectators should be in the designated areas ONLY at all times. That means on the hillside to the west of the stairs and behind the goal, or on the patio.
- Regarding patio seating, the tables should NOT be moved, nor should anyone be bringing their own chairs onto the patio. The tables are spaced to reflect social distancing requirements as outlined by the county. Additionally, people should not be sitting on the tables.
- Spectators SHOULD NOT be up on the deck. The only exception is for filming purposes. Arrangements should be made with the Director of Coaching in advance of the game day to ensure Denver Kickers staff are available and on site.
- The bathrooms are not open. The port-a-potty is the only available bathroom.
- No one except Denver Kickers Administrative staff in the soccer apartment.
- Referees have full access to the Rec Room behind the bleachers.
- Players, coaches and referees should only be using the designated entrances and exits to and from the field. No climbing through the railing, no jumping over caution tape, no crawling under or around other barriers.

AT LONG LAKE

- Per CSA, players and spectators (2 per player) are all sharing a sideline, and only the half of the sideline not being run by the linesman (AR). Players and coaches should be gathered toward the middle of the field, with spectators socially distanced down the rest of the sideline.
- As the home team, please advise visiting coaches about the seating arrangements if they are setting up incorrectly.

AT FAIRMOUNT/CAMP GEORGE

- NO SPECTATORS AT 11 V 11 GAMES.
- Only one spectator per player for 9 V 9 games.
- Per CSA, players and spectators are all sharing a sideline, and only the half of the sideline not being run by the linesman (AR). Players and coaches should be gathered toward the middle of the field, with spectators socially distanced down the rest of the sideline.

ALL LOCATIONS

- Spectators and coaches need to be wearing their masks at all times. There are signs posted all over the clubhouse indicating this restriction, and this is the Jeffco ordinance.
- Players should be arriving and leaving the field in masks, and should be wearing them whenever they are on the sidelines.
- No benches.
- No pinnies while waiting to go back into the game.
